



## HeritageRail Alliance Next Generation Scholarship Application

The HeritageRail Alliance (HRA) Next Generation scholarships are for individuals interested in the railroad preservation industry. The scholarships will assist two people in attending the annual HRA Fall Conference where they will meet others in the industry, learn important topics in seminars, and gain insight into making railroad preservation work a career.

### Rules and Criteria:

- Each HRA member may nominate only one person from their organization.
- Each nominee must be **under the age of 40 as of the first day of the conference.**
- An applicant may receive the award a maximum of two times.
- If chosen, the recipient must be able to attend the annual HRA Conference. If they cannot, their application will be discarded and the scholarship will be awarded to the next "runner-up" applicant. The recipient should notify Lynette Rickman, Executive Director (770-278-0088) as soon as possible so that the alternative winner has time to make all necessary arrangements.

The scholarship covers the following: The cost of registration for the annual conference, including pre-convention trips and the closing banquet, lodging, and \$750.00 towards transportation or food costs. In turn, the recipient is required to attend the activities of the conference, including the board meeting and various seminars.

In addition to this application, the applicant's sponsoring organization must include a short letter telling the committee about the individual and why they are a good choice to be selected. Letters of reference from other members, volunteers, or employees are welcome but not necessary.

Applications may be submitted by postal mail or e-mail to the address listed below by the deadline appearing on the website. All applicants will receive a short confirmation once the application is received. If you do not receive a confirmation and believe your application may not have been received, please contact us immediately.
